The river borders the property and is a short walk or ride from the sections so bring your swimsuit (and a tube or chair) to cool off after the trial. Stay over Saturday night for more riding and/or enjoying the river on Sunday. Four-wheel drive vehicles can drive right to the rivers edge. CTTA will throw some meat on the grill for lunch, so plan on staying after the event for some good ol' BBQ. Bring your own adult beverages, if desired.

*****Warning-The easement road to the camp / pit area is technical, LOOK before you leap, 2wd pickups can easily handle it but take it slowly and plan your route. Don has made it in his van. You can park along C0407 but please don't block the road.**

Start Time: 9:30 am

Where: 22 miles north of Uvalde bordering the Nueces River.

Camping: Camping is encouraged Friday and Saturday night, note easement road warning above.

RV's and trailers **cannot** make it to the campsite / pit area due to the technical easement road. We've made arrangements with Nueces River Adventures <http://www.nuecesriveradventures.com> for RVs and trailers. You can ride your trials bike from NRA to the trails site. Please notify Sander in advance if you would like to camp at Nueces River Adventures. At the trial camp / pit area a fire ring with a grill is available for cooking. A port-a-potty will be on-site.

Hotels: Uvalde is the closest town and has a variety of lodging options. <http://www.visituvalde.com/lodging.html>

Directions: From Uvalde, take US83 to the north side of town to TX55, take a left on TX55 go approximately 21 miles to RR334. RR334 is the first paved road after you cross the Nueces River. Take a left on to RR334. The first county road to the left is C0407 take a left on there. Go approximately 3 miles on CO407 to the easement road. Flagging will start at TX55 and RR334.
